## Daily Dua's

Dua	Arabic
1) Waking up	<p>الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَحْيَانَا بَعْدَ مَا أَمَاتَنَا وَإِلَيْهِ النُّشُورُ</p> <p>All praise is for Allah Who gave us life after having taken it from us and unto Him is the resurrection. [1]</p>
2) Undressing	<p>بِسْمِ اللَّهِ</p> <p>In the name of Allah. [2]</p>
3) Before Entering Toilet	<p>(بِسْمِ اللَّهِ) اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْخُبْثِ وَالْخَبَائِثِ</p> <p>(In the name of Allah). O Allah, I take refuge with you from all evil and evil-doers. [3]</p>
4) Before making wudu	<p>بِسْمِ اللَّهِ</p> <p>In the name of Allah. [2]</p>
5) After making Wudu	<p>أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، وَأَشْهَدُ أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا عَبْدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ</p> <p>I bear witness that none has the right to be worshipped (in truth) except Allah alone, Who has no partner; and I bear witness that Muhammad is His slave and His Messenger. [5]</p>
6) Exiting the Toilet	<p>عُفْرَانِكَ</p> <p>I seek Your forgiveness. [6]</p>
7) Before Eating	<p>بِسْمِ اللَّهِ</p> <p>In the name of Allah. [2]</p>
8) After Eating	<p>الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَطْعَمَنِي هَذَا وَرَزَقَنِيهِ مِنْ غَيْرِ حَوْلٍ مِنِّي وَلَا قُوَّةٍ</p> <p>All praise is for Allah who fed me this and provided it for me without any might nor power from myself. [9]</p>



<p>9) Leaving the Home</p>	<p>بِسْمِ اللَّهِ، تَوَكَّلْتُ عَلَى اللَّهِ، وَلَا حَوْلَ وَلَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ</p> <p>In the Name of Allah, I have placed my trust in Allah, there is no might and no power except by Allah. [10]</p>

<p>12) After the Adhan</p>	<p>اللَّهُمَّ رَبَّ هَذِهِ الدَّعْوَةِ التَّامَّةِ وَالصَّلَاةِ الْقَائِمَةِ آتِ مُحَمَّدًا الْوَسِيلَةَ وَالْفَضِيلَةَ وَابْعَثْهُ مَقَاماً مَحْمُوداً الَّذِي وَعَدْتَهُ</p> <p>O Allah, Owner of this perfect call and Owner of this prayer to be performed, bestow upon Muhammad al-waseelah and al-fadeelah and send him upon a praised platform which You have promised him. [13]</p>
<p>13) Leaving the Masjid</p>	<p>بِسْمِ اللَّهِ وَالصَّلَاةُ وَالسَّلَامُ عَلَى رَسُولِ اللَّهِ، اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ مِنْ فَضْلِكَ</p> <p>In the name of Allah, and prayers and peace be upon the Messenger of Allah. O Allah, I ask You from Your favour. [14]</p>
<p>14) Entering the House</p>	<p>بِسْمِ اللَّهِ وَلَجْنَا، وَبِسْمِ اللَّهِ خَرَجْنَا، وَ عَلَى رَبِّنَا تَوَكَّلْنَا</p> <p>In the name of Allah we enter and in the name of Allah we leave, and upon our Lord we place our trust.</p>



15) Sneezing	<p style="text-align: center;">الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ</p> <p style="text-align: center;">All Praise belongs to Allah. [15]</p>
16) Responding to someone sneezing	<p style="text-align: center;">يَرْحَمُكَ اللَّهُ</p> <p style="text-align: center;">May Allah have mercy upon you. [16]</p>
17) Someone responding to you sneezing	<p style="text-align: center;">يَهْدِيكُمْ اللَّهُ وَيُصْلِحُ بِأَلْسِنَتِكُمْ</p> <p style="text-align: center;">May Allah guide you and rectify your condition. [17]</p>
18) Before Sleeping	<p style="text-align: center;">بِاسْمِكَ اللَّهُمَّ أَمُوتُ وَأَحْيَا</p> <p style="text-align: center;">In Your name O Allah, I live and die.</p>

19) Upon rising from Rukoo	<p>سَمِعَ اللهُ لِمَنْ حَمَدَهُ رَبَّنَا لَكَ الْحَمْدُ حَمْدًا كَثِيرًا طَيِّبًا مُبَارَكًا فِيهِ</p> <p>Allah listens to him who praises Him. Our Lord, to You belongs all praise, an abundant beautiful blessed praise.</p>
20) Before saying Salam in Salah	<p>اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ عَذَابِ الْقَبْرِ، وَمِنْ عَذَابِ جَهَنَّمَ وَمِنْ فِتْنَةِ الْمَحْيَا وَالْمَمَاتِ، وَمِنْ شَرِّ فِتْنَةِ الْمَسِيحِ الدَّجَالِ</p> <p>O Allah, I seek refuge with You from the torment of the grave, from the torment of the Fire, from the trials and tribulations of life and death and from the evil affliction of Al-Maseeh Ad-Dajjal (the Antichrist).</p>
21) Dua in Jahnaza Salah	<p>اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّ فُلَانَ بَنَ فُلَانٍ فِي ذِمَّتِكَ ، وَحَبْلٍ جِوَارِكَ ، فَقِهِ مِنْ فِتْنَةِ الْقَبْرِ وَعَذَابِ النَّارِ ، وَأَنْتَ أَهْلُ الْوَفَاءِ وَالْحَقِّ ، فَاعْفِرْ لَهُ وَارْحَمْهُ ، إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ الْغَفُورُ الرَّحِيمُ</p>



	O Allah, surely [name the person] is under Your protection, and in the rope of Your security, so save him from the trial of the grave and from the punishment of the Fire. You fulfill promises and grant rights, so forgive him and have mercy on him. Surely You are Most Forgiving, Most Merciful. [3].

25) Entering Ihram	<p style="text-align: center;">لَبَّيْكَ اللَّهُمَّ بِعُمْرَةٍ</p> <p style="text-align: center;">[Here I am, O Allāh, making 'Umrah]</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Also Say:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">اللَّهُمَّ هَذِهِ عُمْرَةٌ لَا رِيَاءَ فِيهَا وَلَا سُمْعَةَ</p> <p style="text-align: center;">[O Allāh this is an 'Umrah, there being no showing-off in it nor seeking repute.]</p>
26) Talbiyyah until reaching Masjid Al Haram	<p style="text-align: center;">لَبَّيْكَ اللَّهُمَّ لَبَّيْكَ -</p> <p style="text-align: center;">لَبَّيْكَ لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ لَبَّيْكَ -</p> <p style="text-align: center;">إِنَّ الْحَمْدَ وَالنِّعْمَةَ لَكَ وَالْمُلْكَ -</p> <p style="text-align: center;">لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ -</p> <p style="text-align: center;">لَبَّيْكَ إِلَهَ الْحَقِّ</p> <p>1) Here I am O Allāh. Black Stone

Recite the following between the Yemeni Corner & Blackstone corner. It is preferable to **wipe it** with ones hand (if able to do so)

رَبَّنَا آتِنَا فِي الدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً  
وَفِي الْآخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ

[Our Lord! Give us that which is good in this world and in the Hereafter, and save us from the torment of the Fire]

29) Maqam Ibrahim

Proceed to Maqam Ibrahim, go behind and recite the following:

وَاتَّخِذُوا مِنْ مَّقَامِ إِبْرَاهِيمَ مُصَلًّى

[And take the station of Ibrahim as a place of prayer]

[Indeed, as-Safaa and al-Marwah are among the symbols of Allaah. So whoever makes Hajj to the House or performs 'Umrah - there is no blame upon him for walking between them. And whoever volunteers good - then indeed, Allah is appreciative and Knowing.]

At the Hill of Safa/Marwa, facing the qiblah, recite the following 3 times raising your hands: **Read your own dua after the 1st time of saying and 2nd**

اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ، اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ، اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ  
لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ،  
لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ؛  
لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ،  
أَنْجَزَ وَعَدَهُ وَنَصَرَ عَبْدَهُ وَ  
هَزَمَ الْأَحْزَابَ وَحْدَهُ

[Allāh is the Greatest, Allāh is the Greatest, Allāh is the Greatest. There is none worthy of worship except Allāh alone, without partner. [O Allāh, send prayers and peace upon Muhammad, O Allāh, verily I ask You from Your Favour]
